The Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST) include all the castes, races or tribes, which have been socially, economically and educationally backward. Scheduled Castes constitute about 15 per cent of the total population of the country while Scheduled Tribes constitute about 7.5 per cent of the total Indian Population. Thus, together, these groups constitute a little more than one fifth of the total population of the country. The newly constituted SC/ST cell KMCT CE adheres to the guidelines of the Government of India as communicated by the MHRD and the AICTE with respect to the upliftment of the students and employees belonging to the SC/ST categories and other weaker classes.
